
## THANK YOU FROM VIRGIL GOODE...

I have emailed congratulations to President Obama. It was an honor to head up the Goode/Clymer ticket on behalf of the Constitution Party in 2012. I hope that within the next several weeks we will be able to get the write-in results from 18 states, which I anticipate will increase our vote totals. Even without the vote totals, I believe that we will have the lowest cost per vote of any of the parties which were on the ballot in more than half the states. I am very grateful for the hard work done by local Constitution Party officers and by non-party volunteers. I especially want to thank our Vice Presidential candidate Jim Clymer and our Chairman, Frank Fluckiger, for all of their efforts in this campaign. ## FROM THE CHAIRMAN...



The 2012 General Election is now history. We have received many inquiries regarding how our presidential team, Goode and Clymer, did in each state. The preliminary totals by state are on the national website and we will update them as more totals are made available. Huge numbers of mail-in and provisional ballots still need to be counted. It may be mid December before the states will have those totals available to the public. In the 26 states in which Goode and Clymer were on the ballot, the vote total thus far is 118,272. Votes from the 18 states where they were official write-in candidates will be added to the total as they are received. Texas and Indiana have reported 995 votes from some of their counties and those numbers are not included above.

**South Dakota** takes the honors for the state with the highest vote percentage for our Constitution Party candidates. That state gave Goode and Clymer 2,371 votes for 0.65% and is a 25.11% increase over the 1,895 votes given Baldwin in 2008. Coming in second was the state of **Wyoming** with 1,452 votes for 0.59% which is a 21.81% increase over the 1,192 votes in 2012. This year was the first time ever that the Wyoming Constitution Party was on the ballot as a party and though it is not yet official, it looks like the party's U.S. Congressional candidate, Dr. Daniel Cummings, received enough votes to have the party be ballot qualified in 2014. Much of the credit goes to the state chairman Rex Fritzier and his team of people.

Other states who gave our candidates more votes in 2012 than in 2008 are Michigan, Nevada, New Hampshire, New York and Virginia. When the official counts are in, it appears likely that at least eight additional ballot qualified states will have given more votes to our 2012 team than in 2008. **Michigan** gave Goode the highest number of votes (16,792) and **Virginia** was second with 13,677 votes. Thus far we have little input on the 18 write-in states. We hope to have a final state by state tally some time in December which we will put in the newsletter and also on the national web site. We will also update you on the number of states that have gained or retained ballot access. I extend my sincere thanks to all of our candidates, our party leaders and grass roots supporters who have made this all possible.
